

## TIPS AND OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

### DIRECTIONS TO SPECIAL EVENTS FROM PROFESNI DUM

#### 1. COCKTAIL PARTY

The Cocktail Party is held on Thursday June 28 at 9pm at the Czech National Bank main building, we must use the back entrance at Senovazne Square 30. There will be our students showing the way.

**Walking** (20-30 minutes): This is a nice walk through the most attractive parts of the city. Go across the Charles Bridge, to Old Town Square, continue straight to Celetna Street to the Square of the Republic. The Central Bank is the big gray modernist building on the corner with a sign "Ceska narodni banka" and a statue of a "genius" on the roof (it looks like a small male version of the Statue of Liberty). Go around the building through a passage or around the corner by Senovazna Street. The back entrance is on Senovazne Square, which is small and full of cars.

**By Tram** (20 minutes): Take tram 22 or 23 in front of Profesni Dum (do not cross the street) and go 3 stops to National Theatre ("Narodni divadlo"). There transfer to tram 9 and continue in the same direction 5 stops to "Jindriska". Opposite the tram stop is a gothic city tower behind which is Senovazne Square. The central bank is the big gray building across the square with a big wooden door next to a passage.

**By Metro** (20 minutes): From Malostranska (Green A line) go to 2 stops to Mustek. Take the exit "Mustek" which is at the end of your train. You will exit at the bottom of the Wenceslas Square, take the street "Na prikope" (go left if you look towards the big museum building on the top of the square) towards the Square of the Republic (see Walking instructions from there).

#### 2. SOCCER GAME

The soccer game is on Friday June 29 at 4:30-7:30 pm at Hriste Na Frantisku playground. Two students will take you there from the Registration Desk at 4pm sharp. We will buy a ball. Note: it is prohibited to wear the real soccer shoes, please take tennis shoes. The sport area has toilets, showers, and a buffet for drinks and light food.

**By Tram** (20 minutes): Take tram 12 from Profesni Dum (this time going left, cross the tram rails) and go 2 stops to "Cechuv most". Walk across the Cechuv Bridge, turn left. There are 3 big buildings: Hotel Intercontinental, Hotel President, and a hospital. The playground is behind a wall after the hospital, the entrance is from Kozi Street. (From other directions: take Metro A Green line to Staromestska or tram 17 to "Pravnicka fakulta" where the Hotel Intercontinental is).

If you go directly from the soccer game to the concert, take tram 12 and go back 4 stops to "Ujezd" (see next section).

### **3. CONCERT**

The concert is on Friday June 29 at 8:30 pm in the Popocafepetl Club at Ujezd Street 19. There will be signs on the street in front of the club.

**Walking** (5 minutes): Turn right from Profesni Dum and follow the trams, you will be on Karmelitska Street which after two traffic lights changes into Ujezd Street. The Club is in the first block of Ujezd Street on your right with a blue number 19.

**By Tram** (5 minutes): Take tram 22 or 23 in front of Profesni Dum (do not cross the street) and go 2 stops to "Ujezd". Walk back 50 meters to Ujezd Street 19. (If you come from other directions, get off at Ujezd)

### **4. DINNER**

The Conference Dinner will start after the last plenary session on Saturday June 30. It is a restaurant and a bar at Cihelna Street 2 with a great view of the Charles Bridge. It will be open from around 8pm, the dinner is expected to start around 8:30pm.

**Walking** (5 minutes): Go towards the Charles Bridge and turn left before the bridge starts. Take either Misenska Street or go by the bridge. Turn left to U Luzickeho Seminare Street. There is a small square, take the right street which is Cihelna. After 20 meters you will see a gate with Hergetova Cihelna signs. The restaurant is in the courtyard behind an interesting statue showing a map of the Czech Republic.

**By Tram or Metro** from other directions: Take tram 12, 18, 20, 22, or 23 or Metro A Green line to "Malostranska". Walk in the Charles Bridge direction to U Luzickeho Seminare Street. On a small square, take the left street uphill which is Cihelna. Hergetova Cihelna is at the end of the street on your left.

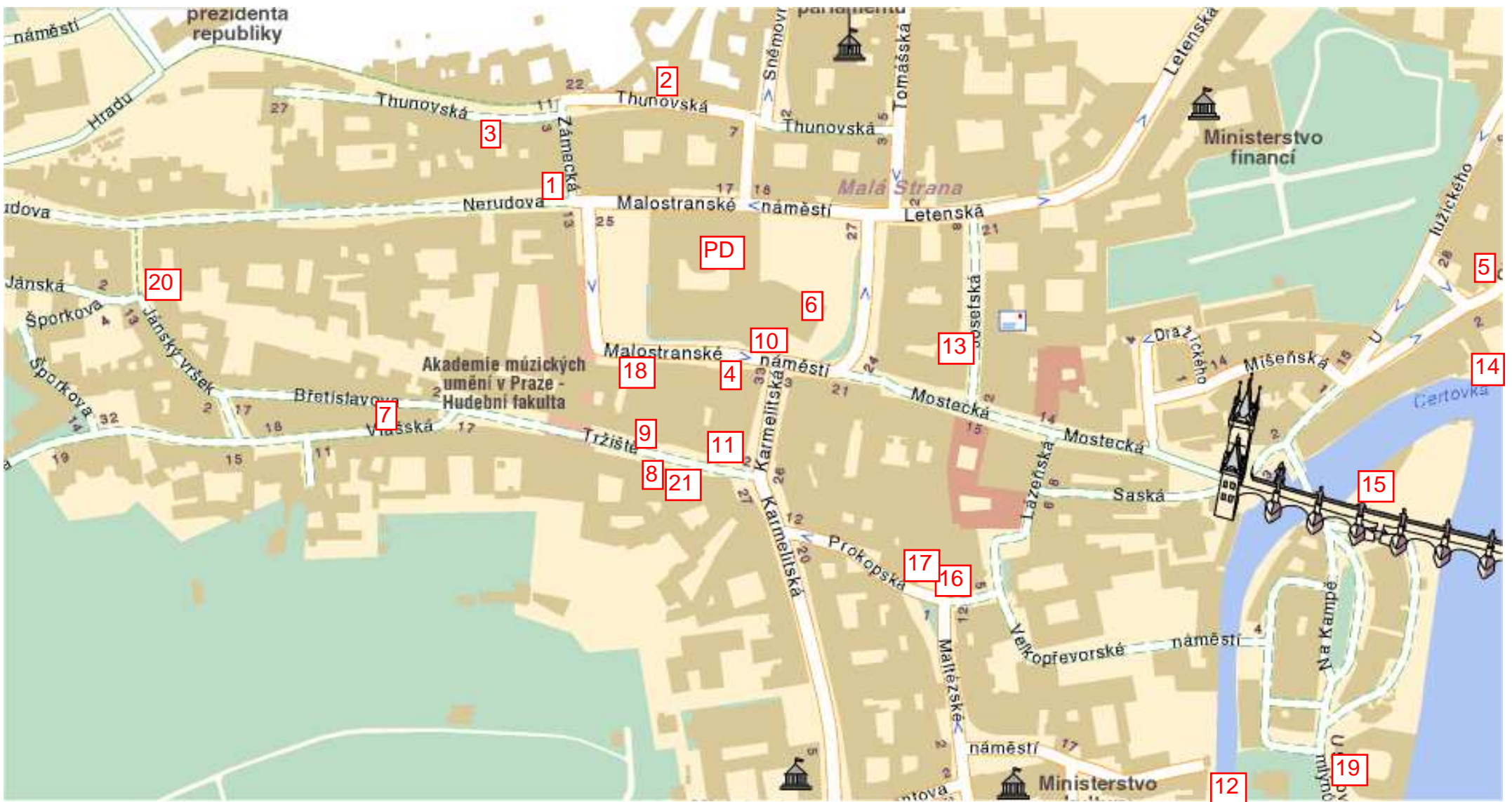
